There are many fees that you will be responsible for paying to UAF as a Plan B NSE student, though you will not be charged tuition or mandatory student fees. Below is an estimate of the fees you will owe; your actual fees will vary depending on which courses you take (this will affect course-specific fees, your textbook fees, etc.), what type of housing and meal plan you choose, etc.:

about \$2,070 On-campus housing about \$2,200 Meal plan about \$1,000 Other fees

A Plan B NSE student living in on-campus housing with a meal plan must pay about \$5,270 per semester to UAF by the Fee Payment Deadline.

Fee Payment Deadline

The above fees will all be due at the beginning of each semester. You will be required to pay for all of your semester expenses outlined above by the following date for each semester (5:00pm if you pay in person at the UAF Office of Bursary, or midnight if you pay online via <u>UAOnline</u>):

Fall Semester 2016: Monday 12 September 2016 Spring Semester 2017: Monday 30 January 2017

How to Pay Your Fees

UAF accepts credit cards, traveler's checks, money orders, and cash. If you are paying with a credit card, the two most common issues that previous students have run into are that the bank or the credit card company:

- does not allow a charge in Alaska, or
- has a daily, weekly, or monthly maximum that is below the amount that the student owes to UAF.

Please contact your bank or credit card company to make sure you won't have these issues. Payment with a credit card will also incur a 2.75% service fee added to the total payment.

If you are unable to pay the entire amount by the deadline, you may set up a <u>Payment Plan</u>. With this option, you can divide the amount into two or more payments spread out over the semester. There is an additional \$50-\$75 fee for this service, and you will have to set up the Payment Plan and make your first payment by the deadline above.

Charges for tuition and student fees will remain on your account until the beginning of the semester. Usually these charges will be removed between 1-10 days before the first day of class. If you make any changes to your schedule after the initial removal of these fees, please make sure that your account is accurate. If you find any discrepancies, please contact our office before the Fee Payment Deadline.

It is your responsibility to resolve any fee payment issues by the Fee Payment Deadline.

| Course Fees | Some courses require special materials, supplies, or services, and require a fee in addition to tuition.
